'Trophy win for 2010 Leconfield Coonawarra Merlot'

Leconfield Wines is proudly celebrating a Trophy win on the eagerly awaited release of the 2010 Merlot.

The 2010 vintage has been awarded Tattersall's Wine Club Trophy for 'Best Merlot in Class', at the 2011 Royal Brisbane Wine Show, complementing the 2008 vintage 'Best in Class' Trophy at the 2009 International Wine and Spirit Competition.

The award marks another strong release for Leconfield, taking its tally to over 100 medals in the past decade.

Leconfield is situated in the heart of Australia's famous Coonawarra with its rich Terra Rossa soil over limestone.

Fruit for this wine was sourced from their Estate Grown vineyards, with the character of the region expressed in the wine.

Paul Gordon, Senior Winemaker at Leconfield Wines since December 2001 is delighted with the result.

"We have been focusing on producing outstanding Merlots from our Estate grown vineyards for many years and this result further cements the enviable reputation that we have achieved. It is further evidence that Coonawarra is the pre-eminent region for Merlot in Australia", Gordon says.

The 2010 Leconfield Merlot presents a medium bodied palate characterised by excellent persistence and soft acidity, crafted to allow for sufficient elegance and softness to make it appeal in its youth, for which Coonawarra has been traditionally famous.
